Lighten Students' School Bags

We would like to seek parents' assistance with the following:

- Choose the appropriate type of school bag for your child. Suitable bags are those made of lightweight material with few compartments and straps that are adjustable and cushioned.
- Inculcate the good habit in your child to bring only what is necessary for the day to school. There is a need to supervise your child when he/she packs his/her bag to ensure that he/she has packed according to the timetable and has avoided bringing unnecessary items to school. Other personal items, if really needed, could be carried in a separate bag to distribute the load.
- Provide a lock for the school locker so that your child can leave some of the items in there such as raincoat, umbrella or stationery.

Attire & Grooming

This is a gentle reminder that students must adhere to school rules with regard to attire and grooming. Please refer to the Student Organiser 2017 for details. All students are reminded to have their Name Tags sewn on their uniform & PE attire. This will facilitate identification in the event of an emergency.

Punctuality

Punctuality is a virtue which we would like to inculcate in our students from young. Students not present during attendance-taking at 8.00am (Mondays) and 7.30 am (Tuesdays to Fridays) will be considered late for school and this will be reflected in the students' report book. Students who arrive after 7.30 am will have their names and classes noted by the administration personnel at the General Office.
